2023 Annual Scholarship Award (Print & return to the library by April 29th, 2023.)

Friends of the Marshall Community Library Scholarship Award

1. Scholarship will be given to one graduating senior who:
 - a. Is attending Marshall High School, or is a resident in the Marshall School District
 - b. Has a grade point average of at least 2.75
 - c. Is planning to continue their education

2. Criteria for choosing recipient:
 - a. Has a history of using the Marshall Library and its resources
 - b. Has demonstrated advocacy for the Marshall Library

3. The Committee will reach a decision by numerical ranking of criteria with total scores determining the recipient.

4. Scholarship may not be awarded in a year if the Friends Scholarship Committee determines there are no qualifying or worthy recipients.

5. Applicants must complete the Scholarship Application and return it to the Committee by April 29th, 2023 along with a copy of their 1st semester report card or other appropriate documentation that shows aptitude.

6. Scholarship Committee will consist of:
 - a. One Friends Board member
 - b. One Library staff member
 - c. One Friends member

7. No Committee member will determine award for a relative.

8. Scholarship will consist of \$250.
